

## Fe 2018 Cabernet Sauvignon

Spring Mountain, Napa Valley

Red wine from United States

Drinking window: 2026 - 2043

The 2018 Cabernet Sauvignon emerges from a six-acre vineyard on Spring Mountain just outside of St. Helena planted with Cabernet Sauvignon, Malbec and Petit Verdot. Rich, powerful and structured, with tremendous nuance, the 2018 hits all the right notes. A whole range of feral, savory and floral notes add striking aromatic nuance, with beams of mountain tannin that give the wine energy. Fe is one of the most exciting debuts of the last few years. I was deeply impressed with the wines I tasted from Fe (pronounced Fee) a new estate on Spring Mountain. This site, rich in iron (hence the name) produces wines of tremendous distinction and character. The Cabernet Sauvignon is the top wine, but the second wine, 26, is equally intriguing. Aaron Pott is the winemaker.
